*Recommendation that **Approval** be given as follows:*

- I. Facilities Management Division Building Custodial Service Contract with White's Maintenance Service. This contract provides custodial service at 1520 Market Street through June 30, 2027, with up to four (4) additional one-year renewal terms. The maximum contract amount is \$6,000,000.00.

Office of Special Events – Request for the following to be **Approved**, subject to certain conditions:

Seven (7) Special Events to be declared as Festival Zone:

1. **St. Lucy's Homecoming at St. Joan of Arc** – event to be held on September 10 from 4 pm through September 14 at 4 pm, on Oleatha between Sulphar and Hampton.
2. **St. Louis Hills Run for the Hills** – event to be held on September 19 from 7 am to 11 am at Francis Park.

DIRECTOR OF PARKS, RECREATION, & FORESTRY

*Recommendation that the following be **Approved**, subject to certain conditions:*

- I. Request submitted by Gateway Pyrotechnic Productions, LLC to conduct a fireworks display in Forest Park on September 16, in conjunction with the St. Louis Symphony Orchestra concert on Art Hill. The display is proposed for approximately 8:15 pm at the bottom of the Grand Basin.

- I. Emergency fleet repairs on four Water Division trucks. The estimated cost of this work is \$18,100.00.

Request submitted by IKE Smart City d/b/a Orange Barrel Media for public improvements at 4301 Manchester Avenue to install an interactive kiosk and shallow foundation within the existing sidewalk in the public right-of-way, including associated conduit, handhole, and meter pedestal, with restoration of all disturbed areas.

- I. Request submitted by Ameren MO to install approximately 125 feet of four new conduits by open trench along Clayton Avenue, including installation of a new bay on an existing manhole, to support the Cortex Iris Apartments development at 4108 Clayton Avenue.
- II. Request submitted by Ameren MO to relocate approximately 220 feet of overhead electrical facilities to accommodate new residential construction at 2140 Oregon Ave. The work includes replacing one utility pole, removing one utility pole and one down guy/anchor, modifying crossarms, and replacing overhead primary wire.
